
1. Voyage summary

Fishing gear configuration:

- 1. Main line length: Straight length of main line between successive branch lines.
- 2. Branch line length: Straight length between snaps and hooks.
- 3. Float line length: Straight length from the float to the snap.
- 4. The number of hooks between floats: if different number of hooks between floats were used, the most representative one may be recorded.

Area of operation

- 1. See the figure below for definition of FAO areas 51 and 57. The area of operation may be marked accordingly. If operated in both the areas, tick mark area 51 and area 57.
