In accordance with Paragraph 4 of IOTC Resolution 06/01 *On establishing a list of vessels presumed to have carried out illegal, unregulated and unreported fishing in the IOTC area* please find attached the Draft IUU Vessels List for consideration prior to the 11th Session of the Commission.


Since the Commission last met, there has been one report of IUU activity provided to the Secretariat. This report, provided by Japan (attached) was circulated to members on 15 August 2006. To-date no comments have been received from CPC's on this report, and there has been no response from the flag state.

CPC's and non-cooperating parties are expected to transmit to their comments on the list at least 30 days before the Annual Meeting and closely monitor the vessels included in the list in order to determine their activities and possible changes of name, flag and or registered owner.

A Provisional IUU Vessels List will be circulated two weeks before the Commission meeting.
