## RE: FEEDBACK REGARDING COMPLIANCE ISSUES

Your letter dated 4 December 2020 (IOTC2020-188), hereby refers.

1. South Africa has not provided all the mandatory information for the list of active vessels in 2019, as required by Resolution 10/08.

Information was provided to the Secretariat on 11 March 2020. Acknowledge of receipt was received from the Secretariat on 12 March 2020 (IOTC REF: ZAF-20027).

2. South Africa has not provided all inspection report, as required by Resolution 16/11.

The inspection report was submitted on 31 August 2020.

3. South Africa has not provided information on IMO number for three vessels, as required by Resolution 19/04.

South Africa revised its list of all its authorised vessels, noting that some of the vessels were no longer operating, IMO numbers was provided for all vessels, except those that are exempted from the IMO scheme. The Secretariat acknowledged receipt and accordingly processed the request (IOTC REF: ZAF-00038).
